

This Transitional Serif font covers all languages written with a Latin alphabet (for 'Eng' it uses the anglo-saxon or Sami shape, which may look odd to users of African languages), although the positioning of combining diacriticals needed for some African languages is poor.

It also covers most languages written with a Cyrillic alphabet (but lacks the now preferred Pe-with-descender for Abkhazian), as well as Greek (both monotonic and polytonic) and the hebrew alphabet.

For variations of the Latin, Cyrillic, and Greek alphabets I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For the other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

## 5 Other variants of the Latin alphabet

There are many more variations of the Latin alphabet in official use throughout the world. Particularly in African countries, and also for vietnamese, some fonts which are otherwise good may have problems. For some of the African languages it is necessary to use combining diacriticals, e.g. *for the epsilon and open o with trema in Dinka – unfortunately, those can look awful, as here.*

### 5.2 Ewe (Ghana and Togo)

*Although this is a tonal language, and the tones can be marked with an acute accent for the rising tone, grave for the falling tone, caron for falling-rising, and circumflex for rising-falling, the tones are only written when needed to avoid ambiguity, e.g. 'mí' (we) vs 'mi' (you plural). A tilde can also be used, as here, to mark nasal vowels.*

## 6 Quotation-marks, etc.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use '...' or "..." but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

left and right single quotes '...'	double low 9 and left double quotes „...“
left and right double quotes “...”	guillemets «...» and angle quotes <...>
single turned comma, right single quote ‘...’	

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.

In Irish, in real life the word 'agus' and is often shortened to 'γ' which is a symbol for the Latin 'et' and it may very occasionally be seen on the web.
