

Old Standard (OldStandard-Regular.otf from oldstandard-2.0.2)

This is described as a font for classical and mediaeval studies. It aims to replicate the style of typeface used in the late 19th or early 20th century, i.e. the Modern style. The name comes from the Standard (Обыкновенная) Russian typeface, with Old to distinguish it from a quite different Обыкновенная Новая “New Standard” typeface. This font covers all European latin alphabets. In cyrillic it covers Macedonian, Russian, Serbo-Croat and Ukrainian. It also covers both forms of Greek, and the Lingala (latin) alphabet (but with bad diacriticals on one capital letter).

For variations of the latin, cyrillic, and greek alphabets I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For the other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

4 Other variants of the latin alphabet

There are many more variations of the latin alphabet in official use throughout the world. Particularly in african countries, some fonts which are otherwise good may have problems. For some of the african languages it is necessary to use combining diacriticals, *e.g. for the accented epsilon and open o in Lingala — unfortunately, those on the capital Open O are mispositioned.*

4.1 Lingala (parts of the Congos, Angola, Central African Republic)

This is a tonal language, using accents: no accent for default low tone, acute accent for the high tone, circumflex for descending tone, caron for ascending tone

5 Quotation-marks, etc.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use ‘...’ or ”...” but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

left and right single quotes ‘...’	double low 9 and left double quotes „...“
left and right double quotes “...”	guillemets «...» and angle quotes <...>
single turned comma, right single quote ‘...’	

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.
